दुचाकीसह मोबाईल चोरी करणारे त्रिकूट जेरबंद

साडेसात लाखांचा मुद्देमाल जप्त; फोन लावण्याच्या बहाण्याने मोबाईल घेऊन काढायचे पळ

मोबाईल व वाहन चोरी करणाऱ्या तिघा सराईतांना वानवडी पोलिसांच्या पथकाने जेरबंद केले आहे. यावेळी त्यांच्या ताब्यातून चोरीच्या १३ दुचाकी, ४५ मोबाईल फोन असा तब्बल ७ लाख ५९ हजार ५०० रुपयांचा मुद्देमाल पोलिसांनी जप्त केला आहे. अश्विनाथ लक्ष्मण नायकवाड (२४), तुकाराम मनोहर चौपटे (२९), रोहित रामप्रताप वर्मा (२९), व. तिपेही महंमदवादी, इडप्सर) अशी अटक केलेल्यांची नावे आहेत. यातील पवित्रसिंग मन्वरसिंग टाक (२९, व. रामटेकडी इडप्सर) हा फरार आहे.

चौपेही रेकॉर्डवरील सराईत मुन्हेगार असून, त्यांच्याविरुद्ध शहरातील विविध पोलिस ठाण्यात गुन्हे दाखल आहेत. शहरातील सार्वजनिक ठिकाणी किंवा रस्त्याच्या काटेला पार्क केलेल्या दुचाकीवर लक्ष ठेवून वनावट चोरीच्या साड्याने हे चौपेही वाहन चोरी करत होते. तर एखाद्या व्यक्तीकडील मोबाईल पाहून फोन लावण्याच्या बहाण्याने मोबाईल

हस्तात घेतल्यानंतर पळ काढत होते. अशा प्रकारे त्यांनी तब्बल ४५ मोबाईल चोरी केल्याचे पोलिसांच्या तपासातून स्पष्ट झाले आहे. यावेळी शहरातील १७ गुन्हे देखील उघडकीस आले आहेत. शहरातील वाहन चोरीच्या अनुषंगाने वानवडी पोलिसांचे एक पथक गस्तोघर असताना, कुम्भानगर

येथील स्वस्तानभुमी परिसरात तीन व्यक्ती संशयानुषंगीत फिरत असताना दिसल्या. पोलिसांना संशय आल्यामुळे त्यांना ताब्यात घेऊन अधिक चौकशी केली असता त्यांनी दुचाकी व मोबाईल चोरी केल्याची कबुली दिली. ही कामगिरी वरिष्ठ निरीक्षक क्रांतिकुमार पाटील, गुन्हे

Bengaluru techie, woman among 3 held for MBA graduate's murder

Remand For Trio In Police Custody Till December 10

Pune: The Sinhgad Road police have arrested three persons – a city businessman, a techie from Bengaluru, and a woman interior designer – in connection with the murder of a 29-year-old woman MBA graduate in her rented flat of Manikbag.

"We have arrested businessman Piyush NM Sancheti (34) of Sahakarwadi; techie Vinayakumar Prabhaakar Gowda (30) of Bengaluru, and interior designer Sunita Sunil Sashre (29) of Ambegaon on the basis of suspicion as the three were last seen having a party with the

deceased. They have not been able to explain as to how the injury marks occurred on the deceased," senior inspector Masdikumar Shelke of the Sinhgad Road police told TOI.

"An analysis of the cellphone belonging to the deceased, including her call data record, enabled the investigators to establish that the tower location of the three suspects was the same as that of the deceased and there were

calls exchanged between the deceased and the suspects," Shelke said. "The investigators have also retrieved the CCTV footage from a building located near the apartment of the deceased and the same showed the three suspects hurriedly walking out of the apartment building," he added.

The three suspects were formally arrested on Thursday. "The motive behind the murder is being ascertained," Shelke said. On Thursday afternoon, the police produced three suspects before the court of the judicial magistrate first class, who ordered their custodial remand till December 10.

Investigations revealed that the deceased came in contact with Sancheti, Gowda and Sashre at a party a few months ago and developed a friendship with them. "Sancheti runs a business of packaged drinking water. Gowda

lives with his wife and son in Bengaluru and had come to Pune for some company-related work. Sashre would take up interior designing assignments," said Shelke. "The deceased had arranged a party in her house and invited Sancheti, Gowda and Sashre. We suspect something went wrong between them and the trio may have strangled her before running away from the scene of crime," he added.

Cyber police crackdown on 2K bank accounts in Rajasthan

PUNE: The Pune police cyber crime cell has cracked down on as many as 2,000 bank accounts in Rajasthan to fight the menace of fraud committed through a private online buying and selling platform, according to Sambhaji Kadam, deputy commissioner of police, cyber crime cell and economic offences wing, Pune.

The online platform allows anyone to buy and sell their belongings without turning it into a business. There have been cases of fraudsters posing as officials of armed forces and duping people by offering to sell their cars. The number of private online buying and selling platform complaints at the beginning of the year was not more than 40. However, the number kept increasing consistently until April, and it reached 120 in May. By July, it had become a stable problem for the cyber crime cell with 70 complaints. That is when the police decided to block the bank accounts used to receive money and the IDs which were involved in it.

"Their targets are not just people in Pune but across the country," said DCP Kadam.

A team of officials is dedicated to the task of identifying and blocking IDs on the platform involved in fraud committed over

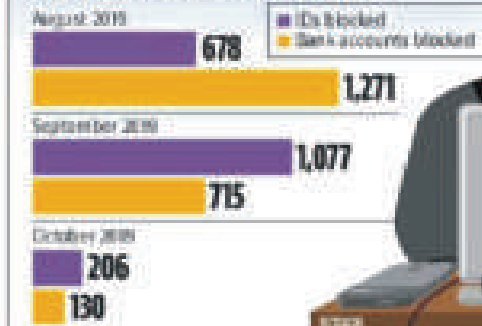

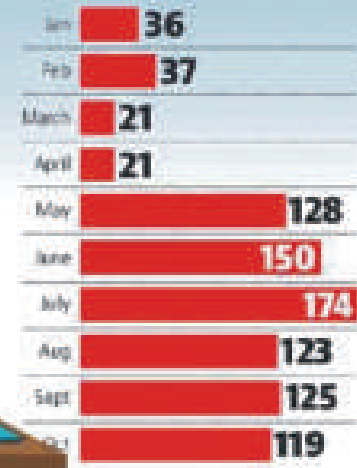

the last 6 months. The solution to the problem, however, is not permanent.

"We have to comb through the records and find the ones involved in fraud. This is not our job, but now we have to dedicate people for the task," said assistant police inspector Sagar Parmar, cyber crime police station.

In the three months of August, September and October, the

police blocked 1,941 IDs and 1,110 bank accounts related to the IDs. On a particular e-mail as well, the police have blocked 1,000 phone numbers and 2,245 IMEI (International Mobile Equipment Identity) numbers.

"This year, we have close to 1,200 complaints of money transfer, including cases of shared OTP (one-time passwords). The next in line is a private online

buying and selling platform where the number of complaints has reached at least 1,200," said DCP Kadam.

The local police in Rajasthan in these areas do not support the investigations when their counterparts from other regions visit their localities. Some of the fraudsters creative in Noida district of Haryana, according to the police.

Man caught after faking death to avoid case

Rajasthan native was accused in land grabbing deal, following which he had settled in Pune

For 10 years, the Rajasthan police had been searching for a man, who has been accused of grabbing an already sold land parcel in Pokhran, Rajasthan. He was absconding after faking his death and had settled in Pune. The pursuit came to an end on Saturday, when the Rajasthan police with help from their Pune counterparts, apprehended the accused, who had married a Maharashtrian girl from the city.

Vishrantwadi police have arrested Bhursingh Ransingh Rathore, who has been staying in Yerwada. Cop had started looking for Rathore, after gaining information from Rajasthan police. They said that the accused was absconding and not dead. He had shifted

to Yerwada, Pune, and married a girl from Ahmednagar, with whom he has three children.

Police constables Vaman Sawant and Sanjay Aswale had received a tip-off about Rathore's whereabouts, who

has been working as a carpenter in the city. The duo posed as customers looking for good furniture design and called him for a meeting at Vishrantwadi Chowk. As he fell into the trap, he was taken to the police station for in-

terrogation. At first, he refused to confess to his crime. It was only when the cops showed him his old pictures attached with the land documents that he gave in.

Senior police inspector Arun Avhad told *Mirror*, "We had put out his picture in the public domain, seeking information. Then, we raked up information on Rajasthani men who had married Maharashtrian girls and came across three such cases. The first couple stays in Hadapsar, the second couple stays in Sanghvi and third couple — which involves the accused — stays in Yerwada. Based on his old picture, it was ascertained that this was indeed Rathore."

In 2010, he had sold his 15-acre land parcel for Rs 16 lakh to a person. At the time, Rathore's brother had claimed that the land could not be sold with his permission. Few months lat-

er, Rathore faked his death and forged a certificate to the effect. It was given to the person who had purchased the land. Suspicious of the whole occurrence, the customer filed a case in the court within a year.

Upon investigation, it was revealed that the documents were forged in order to grab the land. Subsequently, the court ordered that the accused be arrested. Almost nine years later, Rajasthan police came to Pune and approached the Vishrantwadi police. Within four hours, the accused was handed over to Rajasthan police.

A case has been registered in Pokhran police station under Indian Penal Code sections 419 (cheating by personation), 420 (cheating), 467, 468 (forgery), 471 (using as genuine a forged document or electronic record) and 120 (concealing design to commit offence punishable with imprisonment).

पुणे : एखाद्या गुन्हातील आरोपीची काहीही माहिती नसताना त्याचा माग काढणे किती अवघड असते, याची प्रचिती चारंवार पोलिसांना येत असते. पण, पोलिस त्यामधूनदेखील काहीतरी मार्ग काढत शेवटी त्या आरोपीपर्यंत पोहचतातच. एका घरफोडीच्या गुन्हात १२ वर्षे फरारी असलेल्या आरोपीलाही पोलिसांनी अशाच पद्धतीने अटक केली आहे. त्याची काहीही माहिती नसताना फक्त फेसबुकवर आरोपीच्या नातेवाइकाची मिळालेली सेल्फी व दुचाकीचा फोटो यावरून दोन ते तीन महिने छोट-छोटे दुवे जोडून पोलिसांनी अखेर आरोपीला वेड्या ठोकल्या.

कोंढवा परिसरात २२ जुलै २००७ मध्ये दोन घरफोडींचे प्रकार घडले होते. यामध्ये साधारण ४३ हजार रुपयांचा ऐवज चोरिला गेला होता.

फेसबुकवरील 'तो' फोटो ठरला महत्त्वाचा दुवा

गुन्हे शाखा युनिट एकचे पोलिस कर्मचारी अमोल पवार फरारी आरोपीच्या मागावर होते. त्यांनी फेसबुकवर आरोपी व त्याच्या नातेवाइकांची माहिती मिळतेय का ते पाहिले. या दरम्यान, आरोपीच्या एका नातेवाइकाचे फेसबुक खाते सापडले. त्याच्या प्रोफाइलमध्ये एका दुचाकीचा व स्वतःचा एक सेल्फी घेतलाला फोटो पोलिसांना दिसला. दुचाकी मोकळ्या जागेत लावली होती. त्याच्या पाठीमागे अर्धवट काम झालेला इमारत व पाण्याची टाकी दिसत होती. सेल्फीमध्ये एक विजेचा खांब आणि एका घराचा दरवाजा दिसत होता. त्यामुळे हे फोटो कोणत्या परिसरातील आहेत, याचा शोध पवार यांनी सुरू केला. त्या वेळी पाण्याच्या टाकीवरून व विजेच्या खांबावरून तो परिसर गुजरवाडी येथील असल्याचे समजले. विजेच्या खांबाला विशिष्ट डिझाइन होते. यावरून तो खांब ग्रामपंचायतीने बसविल्याचे लक्षात आले. यावरून पवार यांनी आरोपीच्या जवळच्या नातेवाइकाचा पत्ता मिळवला आणि आरोपीचा माग काढला.

या प्रकरणी वानवडी पोलिस ठाण्यात घरफोडीचा गुन्हा दाखल होता. या गुन्हातील काही आरोपीला पकडण्यात आले होते. पण, रियाज रज्जाक मरूळ (रा. अंबिकानगर, विववेवाडी) हा आरोपी १२ वर्षांपासून फरारी होता. त्यामुळे त्याचा विविध पोलिस

ठाण्यांच्या पथकांकडून शोध सुरू होता. पण, त्याच्या विववेवाडी येथील पत्त्याशिवाय पोलिसांकडे काहीच माहिती नव्हती.

तसेच, तो आठ ते दहा वर्षांपूर्वीच विववेवाडी सोडून दुसरीकडे राहण्यास गेला होता. त्यामुळे पोलिसांना त्याचा



अनेक फेसबुक खाती शोधल्यानंतर आरोपीच्या जवळच्या नातेवाइकाचे खाते सापडले. यावरून पवार यांनी आरोपीच्या जवळच्या नातेवाइकाचा पत्ता मिळवला.

तपासाचा एक महत्त्वाचा टप्पा पूर्ण झाल्यानंतर त्यांनी नातेवाइकाच्या माध्यमातून फरारी आरोपीची माहिती काढण्यास सुरुवात केली. त्या वेळी फरारी आरोपी रियाज देहरोड परिसरात राहण्यास गेल्याची माहिती मिळाली. त्यामुळे पोलिसांनी पुन्हा देहरोड परिसरात शोध सुरू केला असता रियाज हा सोमाटणे फाटा येथे

ट्रकवर हमालीचे काम करत असल्याचे समजले. त्यानुसार वरिष्ठ पोलिस निरीक्षक अरुण वायकर, उपनिरीक्षक हनुमंत शिंदे, अमोल पवार, अजय थोरत, योगेश जगताप, वैभव स्वामी यांच्या पथकाने सापळा रचला. अगोदर ट्रकचालकाकडे चौकशी करण्यात आली. त्या वेळी रियाज नावाची व्यक्ती आपल्याकडे काम करत असल्याचे त्याने सांगितले.

पोलिसांनी रियाजची पूर्वाश्रमीची माहिती घेतली असता, तो प्रचंड रागीट असून, पोलिसांच्या अंगावर धावून जात असल्याचे समोर आले होते. यामुळे पोलिसांनी त्याला पकडण्यासाठी चारही बाजूंनी सापळा रचला आणि त्याला अटक केली. चौकशी केल्यानंतर त्याने गुन्हाची कबुली दिली. घरफोडी करून घड्याळ, कॅमेरे चोरून नेल्याचे सांगितले. गुन्हा केल्यापासून घर बदलून राहत असल्याचेही तो म्हणाला.

MPSC aspirant, his friend held for finance co robbery

Police Able To Recover 8.6kg Gold, Getaway Car

Pune: An MPSC aspirant and a casual labourer were arrested from Buldhana and Wajed respectively on Saturday in connection with the Rs 4.28 crore armed gold robbery at the India Finance Limited (IFL) office in Chandarnagar on Thursday.

The police also recovered 8.6kg of the 22kg gold robbed and seized a car that may have been the getaway vehicle. The recovery has been pegged at Rs 1 crore. A hunt is on for two other suspects involved in the robbery, the Pune police said.

The arrested suspects were identified as Deepak Vilas Jadhav (32), a native of Washim district, married to a woman from Buldhana. He wanted to be a government officer and was pursuing MPSC studies.

Sunny Keval Kumar (29), a casual worker from Raviwar Peth, Jadhav was preparing for his MPSC examination and had joined a coaching class. He was found hiding at his father-in-law's house in Area Layout in Buldhana, the police added.

Senior Inspector Shankar Khosle of the Chandarnagar police told TOI, "Our team got a breakthrough after analysing the CCTV footage recovered from the establishments in the vicinity of the IFL office. One of them captured a car with mud passed on its front and rear number plates, moving suspiciously for quite some time near the IFL office. Initially,

the police had difficulty but another footage gave a clear view of the vehicle registration number of the Buldhana RTO."

A Pune police team went to Buldhana to trace it. The police also carried out a technical investigation of the callphones active in the area at the time of the robbery and had secured certain vital clues from their informers about the suspects in Buldhana.

With help from the Buldhana police's local crime branch, the Pune police team, led by as-

sistant inspectors Gajanan Jadhav and Sonawati Tapare, searched the Area Layout house and detained Jadhav. "The car used in the crime belonged to his father-in-law and was found parked in front of the house. It has been seized and the stolen ornaments recovered from the house," AFI Jadhav said.

Jadhav planned the robbery over two months. "He knew the area around the IFL office which is a short distance from his house. One of the two abductees contacted a referee. They knew most of the

employees were women, the office had no security guard and was located on the road for an escape," AFI Jadhav said.

The police officer said a few days before the robbery, Jadhav had told his father-in-law to send his car to Pune as he needed it for some work. The unsuspecting man hired a local driver who drove the car to Pune and handed it over to Jadhav. "He had developed a liking for web series based on crime and would keep watching them. He planned the robbery based on them."

Auto driver held for taking images of cop deployment

Pune: An autorickshaw driver was arrested on Sunday a day after he abused and attacked three policemen when he was caught recording on his smartphone the police deployment minutes before a VVIP convoy passed through the Ambedkar Chowk around 8:40pm on Saturday.

The autorickshaw driver, Pritham Arun Gaikwad (28) from Ambedkar society, was sent to Yerwada central jail after a holiday court sent him in magisterial custody remand.

Assistant Inspector Bahadur Nansaware and two other policemen were deployed at the chowk for the smooth passage of the convoy of Maharashtra Governor B S Kashyari and other VVIP dignitaries. One of them noticed Gaikwad using a smartphone for video-recording their movement and the VVIP handover.

The policemen objected to his act and seized his phone on the grounds that shooting of VVIP convoy was prohibited. Deputy commissioner of police (zone IV) Akhanna Prasad P told TOI, "It is within our (police) power to ban video shooting of VVIP dignitaries for security reasons

Assistant Inspector Nansaware said, "Gaikwad picked up a dispute with us. He hurled abuses and charged at me. He abused my colleagues and started pushing all of us. We tried to pacify him, but he was in no mood to listen. He continued hurling abuses at us. We then took him into custody for the smooth passage of the VVIP convoy."

He said, "We later took Gaikwad to the police station and checked his phone. We came across around 17 to 18 video clips of policemen and traffic personnel in various parts of the city. Gaikwad was abusing the policemen and talking about attacking

them at their residence in the video-clips. He had also made some videos viral on a social networking site in the past. The acts of Gaikwad — attacking, abusing and mistreating with policemen and capturing their images — show that he has grudge against policemen."

Senior Inspector Yama Shaikh of the Yerwada police said, "Gaikwad told the police during questioning that he had developed a grudge against policemen after he was arrested in a molestation case. For opposing the police action, he started video shooting them and abusing them. Gaikwad was initially advised not to film the VVIP handover but he picked up a dispute with the policemen."

Youth looted by thugs, hired by his friend to threaten him

Chaturshringi cops arrested the culprits within 4 hours of the crime

A 19-year-old, who runs a kiosk selling tobacco products and paan at Baner, was looted by two unknown persons at gunpoint. Little did he suspect that the goons were hired by his own friend, from whom he'd been seeking the return of a loan. This was unravelled by the police, resulting in the arrest of the culprits within four hours of the crime.

Late on Monday, Shiva Phulchand Prajapati had just shut shop and climbed into his car to do some deliveries before heading home, when two unknown men clambered into the vehicle as well. According to his complaint, they got in and even as he started protesting, slapped him before pointing the gun at him, forcing him to drive out to the Mumbai-Bangalore highway.

There, they robbed him of Rs 25,000 — the day's collection — at a secluded spot before fleeing. Prajapati filed his FIR at Chaturshringi police station, where cops asked if any names came out during the incident. "I told them that the guys kept hitting me and rebuking me for demanding money from some Arun-bhai. The police asked me if I knew anybody by that name and the only person I knew was a very close

friend — Arun Singh — who I could not imagine doing something like this," he told *Mirror*.

Prajapati had previously lent his friend Rs 8,000 and had been seeking it back. Acting on this information, the cops first picked up Arun Singh, a 27-year-old restaurateur and resident of Balewadi. After extracting a confession from him, the cops said they used his phone to call the two men he'd hired to beat up and loot his friend. This resulted in the arrest of Suraj Raju Chugule, a 27-year-old delivery boy and resident of Vadarwadi, and Rahul Sonkamble, a 19-year-old.

The investigating officer in the case, assistant police inspector Sameer Chavan, explained that Prajapati was clueless about who was behind the attack as the persons who assaulted him were unknown to him. "I am in shock. I cannot believe my friend could do this to me," Prajapati told *Mirror*. The trio has been booked under sections 392 (robbery), 363 (kidnapping), 504 (intentional insult with the intent to provoke breach of peace), 506 (criminal intimidation) and 34 (common intention) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). — **PMB**

3 Nigerians jailed for three years for matrimony fraud

PUNE: Three Nigerian nationals were convicted on Saturday by a judicial magistrate court and sentenced to three years of rigorous imprisonment for duping a woman software engineer of Rs 38.22 lakh in a matrimony fraud case in 2016.

Judicial Magistrate (First Class) MM Raut also imposed a fine of Rs 5 lakh on each of the three convicts, Ogeuri Emmanuel Chinaso (25), Osarumense Smart (30) and Tope Oluwoly (31), who resided in Noida, Uttar Pradesh, at the time of their arrest.

lice station following which Pune city police Cyber-crime Cell had arrested the Nigerian nationals.

According to police, the woman had created her profile for marriage on a well-known matrimonial site. One Dr Rajesh Kumar, who claimed to be an orthopaedic surgeon from the United Kingdom, accepted her profile and they both shared their details and started chatting on Facebook, WhatsApp

and email in August 2015.

Police officials further said that after one month of chatting, Dr Rajesh told the lady that he has received a secret fund of Rs 1.5 crore and that he can't keep that amount with him. Therefore, he wished to send it to her. And as a pretext of receiving that courier, she was asked to deposit amount of Rs 38.22 lakh in 16 different accounts of six different banks. The accused and his accomplice had told

her that the amount was required for paying custom duty, payment to airport authorities and the RBI. However, after getting the amount, the accused persons stopped receiving her calls. She realised she was cheated and approached the police.

After technical analysis and a chase of 15 days in Delhi, a team led by Senior Police Inspector Sunil Pawar, API Sanjay Thenge, PSI Pravin Swami and policemen Aslam Attar, Rajkumar Jaba and staff of Cyber Cell Pune, nabbed the accused.

Police seized three laptops, 10 mobiles, 20 SIM cards, eight dongles used for the crime, from their house search.

Autorickshaw driver arrested for snatching chain from old woman

The accused was in debt and targeted the 75-yr-old

An autorickshaw driver has been arrested for snatching a gold chain worth Rs 1.17 lakh from a 75-year-old woman while she was taking a walk with her two dogs in Karvenagar.

Police arrested the accused on Friday, identified as 43-year-old Shankar Baban Hananagar, a resident of Rajgad Colony in Kamthar Chawl, Karvenagar.

Hananagar has reportedly confessed to the crime, which occurred on December 13, following interrogation. Alankar police have recovered the gold chain. A case under section 302 (robbery) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) has been registered.

According to the police, the accused was an intoxicated man when he snatched the gold chain from the senior citizen. During interrogation, he told the police that he had taken a lot of loans from relatives and family friends. Due to this, he was heavily in debt while his finances were also in a precarious state. Furthermore, both his children are in school and he was stressed about how he was going to be able to pay their fees. He did not have enough money to pay their fees so he decided to snatch the chain.

There is no criminal record against the accused and it was his first time attempting a chain snatching, police said. He was planning to sell the gold chain and use the money to pay for his children's school fees and pay off some of the loans he had taken from relatives, they said.

According to the FIR, the 75-year-old (name withheld) was a resident of Karvenagar for the last 38 years. Her

husband retired in 1997 from an insurance company. The incident happened when the complainant was walking with her two dogs outside the gate off the society she was living in at 4 pm on December 13. Suddenly, an autorickshaw driver appeared before her and snatched her gold chain from her neck. As she was not wearing her spectacles, she did not get a good look at her assailant or the number plate of the autorickshaw. She headed back to her home and told her husband about the incident.

Investigation officer of case, PS(Sa) Gou told Aftab that since the complainant had not seen the number plate of rickshaw, it was challenging for them to find the assailant. "With help of CCTV footage, we identified the rickshaw and its driver at different auto stands in the city. We finally managed to identify him and got him off that he was in Karvenagar. We laid a trap and apprehended the accused," he said.

He was produced in court and has been sent to police custody till December 24.

Wagholi resident who duped 21-year-old of scooter sale arrested

Accused allegedly fled with the vehicle from a mall's parking lot with duplicate key after obtaining ₹30,000

A 35-year-old Wagholi resident has been arrested on Monday for cheating a youth to sell a scooter last month.

According to Virnimal police, the accused, identified as Darshan Agarwal, cheated several other people after they contacted him through a popular online marketplace to buy the scooter. The modus operandi was simple: Agarwal used to meet the prospective buyer at a pre-decided place, and after transaction and key handover, he used to take them for tea and disappear with his vehicle, switching the ignition on with a duplicate key.

However, his luck ran out after 21-year-old law student Prasad Shivajirao Nagargoje lodged a complaint on November 16. A few days before, Nagargoje came across the online advertisements where the quoted price for the scooter was Rs 61,000. After this, he called up Agarwal and settled the price at Rs 40,000. However, Nagargoje set a rider that he wanted to see the scooter first and will pay after that. Agarwal agreed to the proposal.

As per the complaint, the duo decided to meet at the parking lot of a mall in the Virnimal Nagar area around 7 pm. About 7.30 pm, Agarwal came with the scooter. He also showed all documents to Nagargoje, who asked him why he is selling such a well-maintained scooter. Agarwal promptly told Nagargoje that his wife wanted a new scooter and that's why he wants to sell that one. After seeing the vehicle's condition, Nagargoje decided to make an online transfer of Rs 30,000 and pay the rest Rs 10,000 later. Agarwal agreed to that too.

After getting Rs. 30,000 instantly,

Agarwal handed the scooter's key to Nagargoje and told him to take tea in the mall. Nagargoje parked the scooter at the mall's parking and went inside with Agarwal. When Nagargoje and his friend were busy having snacks and tea, Agarwal told them he was getting a call, and came outside the foodcourt. When Agarwal did not return after a long time, Nagargoje called him but found the phone to be switched off.

When Nagargoje and his friend reached the parking lot, they did not find the scooter either. He realised he had been cheated. After 15 minutes, Agarwal called him, saying he was near the mall and coming in a few minutes, and Nagargoje waited for half an hour. When Agarwal did not turn up, Nagargoje called him again, only to be told, "I'm not giving the scooter to you. Do whatever you want to do." Soon after, Nagargoje went to Virnimal police station and lodged a complaint against the accused.

Asst. Aathars, assistant police inspector of Virnimal police station, told Aftab, "A case was registered against Agarwal under Indian Penal Code section 420 (cheating). Later, Agarwal was arrested by Yerwada police who handed him over to us."

2 detained for questioning in MBA grad murder case

ne to Beed and she returned to Pune about a week ago. She was supposed to appear for a job interview with a leading multinational company located on Senapati Bapat road. The other three members stayed back in Beed.

For two days before the murder came to light, the woman was not answering calls of her mother. She came to Pune on Monday evening to check on her daughter. When the woman opened the flat with a spare key, she found her daughter murdered in the bedroom and the police were subsequently summoned.

The police said the two men had met the deceased a few months ago at a party and they became friends. The woman and the two men started

meeting each other regularly. They also visited her house on a few occasions.

The police suspected that since the woman was alone in the flat, they might have decided to have a party during the intervening night of Sunday and Monday. "Things might have gone wrong during the party. A clear picture will emerge only after the questioning of the two detained men," a police officer said.

The police said the woman was searching for employment in Pune and was depressed because she was struggling for a job. The police said both the men were educated and working in private companies. The motive behind the murder was yet to be ascertained.

2 food delivery executives held on charges of assault & robbery

Prime: Two employees of a food delivery aggregator were arrested, while two others were booked on Tuesday evening on the charge of robbing Rs2,300 and two cellphones, collectively worth Rs19,000, from two occupants of a car after pelting stones at the vehicle on Karve Road earlier in the day.

the scooter rider called up his friends. Two more men then reached the spot within couple of minutes," Chavan said.

"The four men assaulted Panchmukh and his tenant and robbed them of Rs2,300 and two cellphones," the officer said.

The two men who had accosted Panchmukh initially were riding a scooter without a number plate. Paste and Choule, on the other hand, were riding a scooter with a valid registration number, Chavan said.

After the robbery the four suspects fled the scene. However, the police made the arrests after identifying the registration number of the scooter with the help of CCTV footage from the vicinity the officer said.

According to the FIR, Panchmukh is a native of Ahmednagar. "He had borrowed his relative's car to drive down to Ahmednagar to meet his ill mother," Chavan added.

Three Nigerian nationals have been convicted with three years of rigorous imprisonment and compensation of Rs 5 lakh each for cheating a Pune-based woman through a matrimonial site in 2016. Judicial magistrate Mandar Raut has pronounced the judgment and convicted Ogueri Emmanuel Chinanso (25), Tope Oluwoley (31) and Olanimawun Smart (32), all residing in Uttar Pradesh when they were arrested back in 2016.

The three were held from Delhi by the then police inspector of the cyber cell Sunil Pawar and his team. As per the complaint filed by the woman, she had registered on a matrimonial site in March 2015. While checking profiles of prospective grooms, she came across the profile of one Dr Rajeshkumar who claimed to be an orthopaedic surgeon settled in the UK. She sent a request for acceptance to Rajeshkumar. Her request was accepted, and she then shared her contact details along with email id and mobile number. When the duo started chatting, Rajeshkumar informed the complainant that he had received a gift of Rs 1.50 crore, which he cannot send to his country, nor to his sister. He further told her that he wanted to send the amount to India, but he has no relatives there. He further asked the complainant to collect the amount, and told that he would send it through courier, which will be delivered to her by a



person from Afghanistan.

A person named Martine called her and asked about her address. He then called again and on the pretext of paying custom duty to airport authorities and the Reserve Bank of India, he demanded around Rs 39 lakh between May 2015 and June 2015 through Internet banking, which she paid. However, when she tried to contact Rajeshkumar and Martine, her calls were left unanswered. It was then she realised that she was cheated on the pretext of marriage. She filed a complaint with the cyber crime branch.

The accused were booked under sections 419 (punishment for cheating by personation), 420 (cheating) of the Indian Penal Code and relevant sections of the Information Technology Act.

The prosecution lawyer proved the case beyond the reasonable doubt and submitted that the offence is a serious economic crime. The court while pronouncing the judgment has stated, "The amount involved in the offence is huge, hence the accused persons are not entitled to the benefit of Probation of Offenders Act."

गाडी महामार्गाच्या दिशेने नेण्यास सांगितली. तसेच तरुणाच्या कानशिलात देखील लगावत गाडी सुस पुलाजवळ थांबविण्यास सांगून फिर्यादीस मारहाण केली. फिर्यादीकडे पान टपरी धारकांकडून जमा झालेली ५० हजार रुपयांची रोकड जबरदस्तीने काढून घेतली. त्यानंतर फिर्यादीस जबर मारहाण करीत अरुण सिंगकडे उधारी मागतोस का ? तुझा धंदा बंद करेल' अशी धमकी देत फिर्यादीस सोडून दिले. त्यानंतर घाबरलेल्या अवस्थेत फिर्यादीने हा प्रकार मावस भावाला सांगून चतुःश्रृंगी पोलिसांकडे फिर्याद दिली. ही कामगिरी वरिष्ठ पोलिस निरीक्षक अनिल शेवाळे यांच्या मार्गदर्शनाखाली सहाय्यक निरीक्षक समीर चव्हाण, पोलिस हवालदार मुकुंद तारु, पोलिस नाईक विशाल साबळे, प्रकाश आव्हाड, सारस साळवी, यांच्या पथकाने केली.

३० लाख लंपास; मोलकरणींना अटक


